#### H. LISTING AND ORDER OF AGENDA ITEMS for Planning Board Meeting

#### I. Briefing, Information, Question & Answer

- Community Relations Officer, Tracey Williams, reported that recently Torrey Pines High School was locked down due to threats posted online via a website called Yik Yak.
- He stated that Canyon Crest Academy was threatened as well, and that the threats were traced back to some local young adult minors.
- On a side note, Officer Williams reminded the board that burglaries are generally up during this time of year due to people leaving holiday shopping bags in their cars. He also urged everybody that has an alarm system at their home to use it, as they are the best deterrent against burglars.

## 1. Sorrento Valley Trunk Sewer Abandonment – presentation by Francis S. Marquez, City of San Diego – PWD - ROWD

- Francis Marquez reported to the board regarding the city's plans to pump cement into two sewer mains for abandonment purposes.
- One sewer main is 10-inches in diameter and the other is 18-inches in diameter.
- Both sewer mains are located on the Los Penasquitos Lagoon and work is expected to take place from December 2014 through February 2015.
- According to Francis Marquez, the City Public Works Department will be funding the project.

#### ITEM 1: DISCUSSION: Update on One Paseo - Dee Rich/Dennis Ridz

- On January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015, the City Council will meet to discuss and vote on the One Paseo project. The meeting will start at 6 p.m. at Golden Hall in San Diego.
- It was discussed that the Torrey Pines Community Planning Board met with representatives from other planning boards regarding One Paseo.
- Noel Spaid along with other board members urged that a meeting should be set with the Mayor's Office to provide information and insight on the project.

#### B. Councilmember Lightner - Allison Don

- Allison Don reported that Councilmember Lightner has accepted the new role of City Council President.
- On December 17<sup>th</sup>, from 4 p.m. 6 p.m., Councilmember Lightner's office will be handing out reusable shopping bags in front of Sprouts Market in University City. This is to raise awareness to the plastic shopping bag ban that will go into effect in 2015.

- Pat Whitt discussed the San Dieguito River Valley JPA meeting, and stated that things sounded positive.
- Jake Mumma discussed the new trail delineation/fencing that was installed in Crest Canyon. The fencing was installed by Parks & Rec. to close social trails that had been started in sensitive habitat areas.
- Dennis Ridz reported that the board is waiting to hear where the Torrey Pines Community sits on the list for a Community Plan Update.
