**Transportation and Public Safety**

**Vision Zero**

- **Strategic Plan** – engineering, education and enforcement (three “E’s”)
- **Safety Initiatives** – Improving how **we design and install crosswalks**
  - **Developing pedestrian plans**
  - **Targeting needed improvements on streets**

If warranted improvements cannot be funded in a given year, these improvements should be placed on the Transportation Unfunded Needs List in accordance with **Council Policy 800-14**

**Environmental Justice**

**Project Reviews** – assist City in developing building and safety codes applicable to:

**Fire safety near High Fire Zones** as shown on City Fire Maps

**Placement of fire monitoring** equipment in Torrey Pines Annex

\***Air Quality and Noise reduction standards** (within homes 500 ft from I-5/SR-56 )

\* **Review unfunded ‘Sound Wall(s)’** -consider for DIF

\* **EIR for I-5 NCC & I-5/SR-56 data**

**Del Mar Hills Academy Playing Fields** – consider “**Joint Use**” to replace lack of 17 acres of recreation land.

Revisit **Crest Canyon Passive Park** for 1 acre vista open passive parkland

Develop funding plans to purchase the Del Mar Hills Performing Arts Center for future use as a Senior Recreation Center.

### **Developer Impact Fee (DIF) Study & Projects**

Reassign DIF **Storm Water funding** to handle issues of flooding on residential streets such as **El Amigo** and **La Amatista** that drain into the City of Del Mar.

**Work with City and State officials supported by local developers to identify suitable sites for moderately priced housing within Torrey Pines.**
